Meeting Minutes

May 10, 2010

Opening: The May Band Boosters Meeting was called to order by the President, Doug MacAdams at 7:00 pm on Monday, May 10, 2010.

Joel Galway requested that a committee be formed to help him plan the Spring 2011 Band Trip. Mr. Galway would like the dates of April 15-17th, 2011 to be used through the "Fiesta-Val Competition". He would like a team to find out the information and have it distributed to the students by the second week of school in September.

Mr. Lewis stated that his wife Angel would head up that committee. Mrs. Lewis will set a date to invite parents to help with the planning.
