They will offer Green Salad, Italian dishes and Garlic bread. The cost per person will be \$10. All tickets will be prepurchased; no tickets will be sold at the door.

Doris Harlow and Jessie Hovatter will be working on a slide show to play during the dinner hour at the Marching Band Banquet.

Toni and Mark Ballard have offered to head the nominations of the new Board of the Band Boosters.
