May 14th, 2012

Opening: Meeting was called to order by the president, Carola Fisher, at 7:05. There was a review and approval of the April minutes. Carola Fisher moved to approve the Meeting Minutes. Marie Tsuda seconded the motion.

Treasurer's Report:

Marie Tsuda presented the April Treasurer's Report. Marie noted that we are currently at a low for paying all the fees of Drumline. We are looking forward to receive the first payment of the marching band members for the Spirit of Freedom on May 31st. Marie also reported that the 501c3 penalties are currently a zero. Carola Fisher moved to accept the April Treasurer's Report and Nancy Deluski seconded the motion.

Fundraising Report:

Barb Orson noted that we held a booth at the ANGC Yard Sale on Saturday, May 5th. We sold a few snacks and spirit wear, but there was not much business.

We will be selling spirit wear and snacks at the upcoming concerts on May 15th and May 17th.

Carola Fisher announced that we will be having another "Genghis Grill" night on Tuesday, May 22nd.

Diane Hill and the Spirit wear Team are developing an order form for embroidery items to sell at the concerts as well. We have hired a local artisan to put embroidery emblems on shirts, visors, and duffle bags.

Diane suggested boosting volunteerism by offering parents a free t-shirt that has our logo on the front and the band supporters on the back. Barb Orson motioned to support this idea of giving a t-shirt to parents who volunteer the most. Marie Tsuda seconded the motion. All were in favor. Barb Orson will be seeking volunteers to be printed on the backs of the t-shirts.

Joel Galway Report:

Mr. Galway reported briefly between band rehearsals that the concerts would be coming up on the nights of May 15th (concert band and percussion) and May 17th (wind symphony and orchestra).

Mr. Galway is holding marching band try-outs on May 10th, 24th, and 31st. If a student recruits a member to the Colorguard, they will earn \$100 toward their band fee. We currently have 18 students interested in Colorguard. We are expecting 25 new marching members this year. The "Pursuit of Joy" is

the title for this year's theme. We are looking forward to a great season. Mr. Galway would like the Boosters to help with the collection of money on the evening of the 31st.

New Business:

The Executive Board met to determine the scholarship recipient on Monday, May 7th at 7pm at Marie Tsuda's home. The recipient will be announced by Carola Fisher on Tuesday, May 29th at the senior awards.
