Mr. Galway presented the 2012-2013 budget for the Marching Band. It will take approximately \$40,000 to operate. Tag Day will be our largest fundraiser. It is set for September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2012. All marching band members are expected to participate.

## **New Business:**

Diane Morrical is working on an interactive parent form to be placed on the website for volunteering. She is also working with Diane Hill and Carola Fisher to put together a spirit wear order form to be available on the website.

The website will recognize the recipient of the 2012 FHS Band Booster Scholarship.

Barb Orson and Nancy Daleuski worked hard to get the band uniforms taken to "Zips" dry cleaners. They charged us \$1.75 a piece to be dry cleaned.

Julie Kemp and Shannon Dingus will be hand washing the past Drumline uniforms in July for reuse or resell.

Dana Van Slyke presented a plan for volunteerism for Band Camp 2012.

There was a lengthy discussion about the Spring 2013 trip. It was decided that a trip to Hawaii would be too costly. We will be looking into other site locations. Some suggestions were: New York City, Myrtle Beach, Nashville, Gatlinburg, and Atlanta.
