On March 2 the All District Assessments for Concert Band and Wind Symphony will be held at Heritage High School. Mr. Galway is asking for 4 – 8 chaperones to help out. The groups will be traveling separately. The Concert Band Assessment is in the morning hours. The Wind Symphony Assessment is in the afternoon hours.
