Currently 60 students are signed up. More students are encouraged to go as we have sufficient chaperones for the numbers.

Dana VanSlyke will head up the Spirit of Freedom band camp. Uniforms need to get dry cleaned asap (after Myrtle Beach). A new canopy will be needed. Toni Ballard and Dana Van Slyke will take on the uniform fitting for marching band.

Fundraising Report: The participation in the Dessert Fundraiser was very low. Some new suggestions for fundraisers were candy bars and Bingo Night. The poinsettia and orange sales seem to do well.
