The scholarship funds must be utilized for school expenses only. The band booster treasurer will forward a check written directly to the institution in care of the recipient.

If a recipient fails to complete his or her obligations as outlined, the unused scholarship and/or forfeited funds will remain the property of the Freedom High School Band Boosters.

Please complete the entire application and turn into Mrs. Greiner in the Career Center by Tuesday, April 18, 2017. No exceptions will be made and all decisions are final. The scholarship recipient will be announced at the Senior Awards ceremony.

Applicant Criteria:

- Applicant must be a student engaged in one or more aspect(s) of the Freedom High School Band program.
- Applicants must be a graduating member of the senior class of Freedom High School.
- Applicants must be bound for an institute of higher learning to include college, university or technical school.
- Applicants must have attended FHS for at least one year
