**President’s Report:** Linda Kupsky

- Spiritwear has been distributed; **except one order to be remediated**
- Show shirts still being passed out; **anyone who does not have one should contact Linda**
- Mattress sale items have been picked up; **except one in band practice room**
- Joel asked to look into food for this BOA competition at Liberty U.: if we make it to finals, the bus drivers will need to go to a hotel. **Will contact campus dining hall or BOA organizer if they can accommodate our band for dinner or find out ability to eat in stadium given volume of kids or walk across to other fast food options.**
- This Saturday 10/26/19, 4:15am call time. Kids need to eat breakfast before or pack their breakfast and lunch
- LCPS does not allow eating on the buses: **boosters will stock bus with garbage bags and make sure chaperones know to check if kids are cleaning up buses**
- Disney trip coming up: kids pick and sign up together 4-5kids/room and bus partner, usually >=3 kids together at all times in park with cell phone text check-ins with selfies, chaperone 2 adults/room, more details to follow.
