**Treasurer’s Report:** Jodi Goldberger

- Marching Band fees due July 1- some paid 1st payment already into Charms and Online School Payments, **will update Mr. Galway payments from Charms**
- Request to outline what Marching Band fees pay for (% transportation, staff, competitions, etc)- Mr. Schiffler is updating accounting Mr. Galway has set up.

**Band Director Report:** Mr. Galway/Mr. Schiffler

- Mr. Schiffler has used Sign Farm for trailer rewrap for ~\$3,000 without removal of old wrap, **Nancy will email for estimate and design mock ups.**
- Governor to make announcement 6/9 and LCPS by 6/26 for fall, will conservatively move forward with season (not purchase custom uniform tops, have semi-arranged music, try to reuse props), will explore other opportunities if no MB this fall (Indoor Winds, etc)
- Marching Band sign up current total = 116 members
- Mr. Galway getting Mr. Schiffler set up, sharing info, finishing grades, reconciling band fees, **Boosters will need to help with cleaning uniforms returned before next year.**
