**President’s Report:** Linda Kupsky

- Trailer- discussion regarding rewrap- Pros: boosters have the funds, trailer not being used by students at this time. Cons: may need funds for unforeseen expenses, extreme weather can fade wrap. Decision to temporarily hold proceeding with trailer rewrap and revisit in 6 months
- Fundraising- TAG day may be best as a virtual campaign with coordinated effort from all Fine Arts Dept. Proceeds can potentially be split by looking at past performance percentages. Mr. Schiffler to discuss with Dr. Fulton and Fine Arts dept heads.
- Executive board officers- some terms are done in December- this (COVID19) year may need to extend terms since Marching Band season has moved and within Bylaws of <=3years

**VP Operations Report:** Jen Wroniewicz

- Will work on recruiting 1-2 persons for logging Uniforms in online system as able with Kelly Good transitioning
- Band Booster Website- would like to switch to a different platform that is easier to use, can be a tool for communication, branding, informing middle schoolers, to include pictures, etc.- Mr. Schiffler can assist building content (band classes, fingering charts)

**VP Drumline Report:** Michelle Taylor

- Spiritwear store online- will have masks, PJ bottoms, shirts, etc once eagle logo determined

**VP Logistics Report:** Kevin Danford

- Trailer/C container- discussion on how to best secure: motion sensor light, alarm, camera or moving trailer closer to school under surveillance cameras.
- Email report 8/8/2020:

“We learned the locks from the band trailer were again missing. Inventory check revealed the only apparent theft was of 2 wire-cutters used for props, 4 pair of inexpensive work gloves, 8 blue tarps (6x9 feet) 1 large blue tarp (12x16 feet), and the three locks on the trailer. Total loss roughly \$190.

The two locks in the C-container were intact, but based on an inspection of the locks and their position, it appears someone was interrupted while trying to pick them. There were no marks of attempted cutting. One lock was in picking position and it looked like someone had started on spring manipulation. There were no scratches where a novice would be expected to leave some, so my guess is whomever did this knows locks pretty well.

Going forward:  
I replaced the three locks in the trailer.”
